Our course is designed to be flexible. Based entirely online, it requires only **15 hours of study per week**, which can be done at whatever time and wherever suits you. Plus, the course fees - just **£5,220*** - can be paid in **modular instalments**.

During the course you will:

- 1 Explore key themes that will enhance your practical, business-based and management skills.
- 2 Develop your understanding of the cultural and ethical contexts in which international business operates
- 3 Discover the impact that commercial leaders and their decisions have on society.
- 4 Gain a full undergraduate degree and skill set employers will value.

Modules

Our Top Up is delivered through a flexible carousel structure. The order in which you study your modules will depend on factors such as when you begin the course or if you take any breaks. However, by graduation, you will study all six modules* listed below:
